The Department of International Studies at CIDE (Centro de Investigación y Docencia Económicas) offers a position as Visiting Professor (post-doc or senior academic) in International Political Economy at its Santa Fe campus (Mexico City). The research topic of the candidates should be related to trade, investment, global value chains, emerging economies, or related areas, and should focus on Latin America and/or North America. The duration of the appointment is for one year, renewable to a second year. The starting date is flexible during 2018.

The Visiting Professor is expected to contribute to the development of divisional initiatives and research, teaching and outreach projects. Candidates must have a doctoral degree at the time of hire. Spanish skills are required.
